Fire Commissioners Report Month of March 2017

- 1. The Bureau website is operational and we are now accepting online payments. In addition, we are having real estate agents request appointments online to cut down on the time our staff is on the phone; this seems to be working quite well so far.
- 2. All letters have been sent out for past due monies owed for registration / penalty fees.
- 3. A new 4-story apartment building is being built downtown (55 apartments); concerning firefighting capabilities, I have requested under the fire code, provisions be made for Emergency Responder Communications.
- 4. I spoke with Dave Roberts, Township Planner about future development and he states that under the adopted Housing Plan Element, there are 23 sites with a total of projected buildout of 2,930 units. There is no specific location of these units but he did state that several of the sites would also have a commercial component.
- 5. Over 75 LHU letters explaining to businesses about past due fees owed to the state have been sent out already; we are still working on this list as this list is quite long. I have been informed that the State is starting to collect some of the past due fees.
- I had a meeting with Dover Woods on Tuesday; the no smoking ban inside the building will remain in effect. We also compromised on the penalty fees owed and they will be donating to the Pleasant Plains Fire Company.

- 1. FF1/2 Class is in its final stages with final testing to start on 3/22.
- 2. Work has started on replacing undersized drain pipes under the main door ramps and leaking gutters and down spouts.
- 3. Fire Fighter 2 course began Feb 1 with 8 students and is progressing.
- 4. Instructor work day was held on March 4. Cabinets were installed creating 2 kitchen props in the burn building. Maintenance was done on the burn rooms, pallet pile was cleaned up and rearranged, utility room cleaned and made code compliant, apparatus bay cleaned several rooms re-lamped and damaged ceiling tiles replaced. New cabinets installed in apparatus bay.
- 5. Mandatory training programs (Haz Comm, Blood borne pathogens, Haz Mat Ops refresher, CPR, etc) have been completed. Make up session will be held for Dist 1 and 2.
- 6. February FTC Calendar attached.
- 7. Front east side Overhead door repair completed. Wear and tear after 20 + years of service. Recommend a maintenance contract or regular preventive maintenance on the doors.
- 8. Clandestine Drug Lab class held 3/1/17.
