- 1. FF1/2 Class Graduation to be held May 22 at 1900 hrs. Except for the original 4 drops all of the students completed the course.

Toms River Bureau of Fire Prevention Fire Commissioners Report Month of May 2016

- 1 A meeting regarding the Bureau accepting credit card payments was held on Thursday April 28, 2016. We met with Mr. Anthony Pontieri from Merchant Advocate. After a lengthy discussion, we would like to move forward with this project. Initially, we estimate startup costs of around \$500 (Initial fee's and equipment). Mr. Pontieri will be handling all necessary requirements for contacting the necessary companies to setup our accounts and negotiate any fees. Mr. Pontieri stated there would be no costs to Toms River Fire Commissioners for his services. It is our understanding that we can charge a convenience fee for online payments not to exceed roughly \$3.00 but still need to confirm this.
- 2. The new Bureau website has been up and running for a few months now. We continue to add and make improvements to the site. Lead Inspector Kevin Esposito has been working with the Township Information Technology staff on how to setup the site for online payments. Currently, we do not have an exact cost for setting up the website for online payments and will advise once any costs are established.
- 3. We have been continuously working with Mobile Eyes and Spillman on how best to transfer data from Mobile Eyes to Spillman. We have another Mobile Eyes/Spillman interface conference call scheduled for Friday May 13th.
- 4. The Bureau has been receiving inquiries from insurance company representatives regarding each Fire District's Insurance Services Office (ISO) Public Fire Protection Rating. It would be beneficial if each District had their ISO rating posted on their respective websites. We will also add this information to the Bureau's website.

5 We received copies of Suez Water Company's water districting map at the Fire Official's quarterly meeting that was held on May 3, 2016. A copy of the map will be provided to each District.
