COMMUNICATIONS-No report

FIRE ACADEMY- Latshaw stated the electric has been completed for the washer and dryer. Thanked Joe Brown for his diligence in getting the RIT project complete.

Hansson submitted a report (See inserted report). He additionally stated FF Level II has been added as a stand-alone course to start in December. FF Level 1 & 2 has been altered to combine with the existing Level II. This cuts down on approximately 24 instructor's spots.

Convery asked if there were any questions for Director Hansson.

Ambrosio replied: prior to the budget meeting in reference to the end of September you only used 44% of your current payroll. What is proposed for the second Level I/II? Will you be under or over budget for 2017? What was the previous cost for these classes? Requesting answers prior to the next meeting. He also stated there were significant transfers out of line items and yet the budget did not go down for 2018. Hansson stated he believes his operational budget was reduced by almost \$50,000.

<u>BUREAU</u> – Convery stated the renovations are underway at the Bureau. The tentative date for completion is the 2nd week in December. Chief Fire Inspector Esposito submitted a written report. (See inserted report)

Ambrosio made the following statement: Historically the Board of Fire Commissioners request that each department that submits a budget stay within a 2% cap. Being able to transfer large sums of money out of line items for 2017 should reduce those line items in the 2018 budget. If the new 2018 budget remains as it stands now with no changes he will vote no to the budget.

ADMINISTRATOR KUBIEL-Kubiel stated he was contacted by a NJ state inspector re: the propane tanks at the fire academy. These tanks were supposed to be registered and inspected starting in the mid 80's. Several violations need to be addressed. Moving forward the inspection for the tanks will be placed in the yearly rotation.

Toms River Fire Training Center Report November 2017

- 1. The lectern for the new classroom was received and is awaiting AV hookups.
- 2. Outside agencies using the facility in October; Professional prep for a classroom rental. Professional prep has also reserved rooms for December and two dates in January. Toms River DPW JIF Training, Toms River Records Director for a Statewide Conference. Sr Health Education, OC Prosecutors Office, NJDFS Arson K9 drill, Point Pleasant Beach Fire Co (2), Island Heights (2), Jackson Mills(2), Beachwood VFC (2), TRPD ESU, NJ Fire Sprinkler Coalition.
- Toms River fire companies conducted live burn drills seven times during the month of October. They also made use of the burn building and other props for other Drills and Training.
- 4. Extrication Class has been completed. The class was full and all students, except 1 from Sta 55, are from TR Fire Cos.
- Several props to be used in RIT/RIC training, have been completed by Instructors. These props are in addition to those constructed previously by Inst. Joe Brown.
- 6. Fire Police Officer Class was held Oct 23,25 and 29. Five out of town students were registered in this class.
- 7. Firefighter 1/2 Class is continuing with 17 students. Quarterly exams and evaluations will soon be completed and CO. Chiefs will be advised of their students progress.
- 8. Lakewood Fire Dept. will be training at TRFTC during the month of November. This is the third time this year that Lakewood has conducted live burn drills at our Academy.
- 9. The electrical work required for installation of the washer and dryer has been completed. The plumber was here on 11/7 to lay out the mechanical work necessary.
- 10. On 4 dates during November there were 4 simultaneous activities in progress at the academy and the academy was in use on 23 days for one or more training functions including four weekend days.
