Commissioner Bierbaum stated he is honored to be sitting in the Fire Commissioner seat. He would like to thank Robert Blank for his years of service. Looks forward to working with the fire companies and commissioners from both districts. He stated he is open to input and guidance as he moves forward. In the near future, he would like to see several items discussed further such as: annual report, fuel tracking plan, development of a severe weather plan, officer transition plan, homeland security, firefighter continuing education plan and to improve the radio and communication ability.

Charlie Russell congratulated Commissioners Craig Bierbaum, Brian Geoghegan and Ray Latshaw. He made the following statement: These are his comments and no one else's. Wanted to make the joint board aware of situation that has occurred within the Pleasant Plain Fire Department and some of its members. There is a retaliatory action initiated and carried out by members of Pleasant Plains Fire Company and against multiple people with their employers. There was a complaint filed with his employer and could personally and professional affect his

life. He feels this is a violation of his first amendment right and is requesting the board to use any authority that is allowed by statute to stop the harassment and intimidation of people. He is also asking for members of the Pleasant Plains Fire Department to cease and desist against any retaliatory action against him. A complaint was filed with Administrator Gargano in February and has still not heard anything back from this complaint.

Commissioner Sipe asked if any of these complaints are against the fire dispatchers, Bureau of Fire Prevention or fire academy personnel, which encompass the joint board. He responded not directly.

The commissioners agree that this is a District No.2 issue and will be addressed by their board.

Toms River Fire Training Center Report March 2018

- 1. Building Construction Class completed. 6 students. This class is required for Fire Officer 1, which in turn is required for election to Fire Officer Positions in the TRFD.
- 2. Outside agencies using the facility in February and March: CPM Class, Island Heights FD, Whitesville FD, Beachwood FD, Lakehurst VFD., OC Prosecutors Office, TRPD, TR Twp. Drills by outside Cos. Are scheduled through November
- 3. Toms River fire companies conducted live burn drills 3 times during the months of February and March. They also made use of the burn building and other props for other Drills and Training.
- 4. Standalone Firefighter 2 class is continuing with seven students.
- 5. Maintenance completed on Propane tanks and associated equipment by Suburban Propane.
- 6. Firefighter 112 Class is continuing with 14 students. Midterm exams and evaluations have been completed and Co. Chiefs were advised of their students' progress. All FF 1/2 Students passed the State Haz Mat Awareness and Operations exams. March is the last full month of the class. Graduation will be in mid April. Date TBA.

7.State required mandatory training classes are continuing. Hazcomm and HazMat Operations have been completed. Participation has been very good. March will be SCBA recert. All mandatory training will be delivered on at least 6 drill nights giving all members the opportunity to attend.

8. Gear washer and Dryer have been installed. We are awaiting arrival and installation of soap and dispenser to begin using the system. Dented panels for the dryer will be replaced this week.

- 9. Kitchen cabinets have been installed. Thanks to Instructor Ken Taylor who donated three boxes of high quality tile and instructor Joe Brown who installed the tile on the backsplash. The backsplash project was completed at minimal cost.
- 10. Fire Facilities completed warranty repairs to the first floor bum room.
- II. Training and Drill requests have been received from 6 outside fire departments including multiple requests from several.
