Toms River Fire Training Center Report February 2019

- 1. Fire Official class is continuing, 17 students registered. First time this class has been offered at TRFA.
- 2. Outside agencies using the facility in January and February: Lakewood PD Special Ops, Twp of TR safety training, Island Heights VFC, Toms River PD, OC Fire Prevention Assoc.
- 3. Toms River fire companies conducted live burn drills 3 times during the months of January and February. They also made use of the burn building and other props for other Drills and Training.
- 4. Stand alone Firefighter 2 class started Feb 4 with 11 students. The Art of Reading Smoke class will be held on Feb. 26 with 20 students registered so far.
- 5. Maintenance and improvement projects for 2019 are being planned.
- 6. Firefighter 1/2 Class is continuing with 22 students. Mid-term exams and evaluations have been completed and CO. Chiefs were advised of their students progress. All students passed the State Haz Mat Awareness and Operations exams.
- 7. State required mandatory training classes will start in February. All mandatory training will be delivered on at least 6 drill nights giving all members the opportunity to attend.
