VEHICLE REPAIR/NEW APPARATUS—Convery stated vehicle maintenance is 75% through the budget. A meeting to be scheduled with the District Chief, Administrator Kubiel the liaisons and chiefs to establish maintenance procedures.

Sipe asked if the alarm issue was resolved for 2624. Kubiel stated this has been looked into and they cannot silence it but will look into lowering the decimals.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT- Administrator Kubiel stated:

- 1. The truck reports have been submitted for the commissioners' review
- 2. Firefighter CJ Weinberger has requested to come back to active status. Currently the bylaws do not allow.

REPORTS OF FIRE OFFICERS

DISTRICT CHIEF GOLDEN- (See inserted report) Golden continued to state:

- 1. There have been several complaints that (William Roncskevitz, Toms River OEM 505) is stationed at the command post, he wanted it on the record that he will continue to be at the scene and if anyone has an issue with it to contact him.
- 2. The dispatchers have done an excellent job in the past several weeks.

Convery addressed Captain Oneill, commending him for an excellent job at a recent fire.

CO. 1 CHIEF MUTTIE – Muttie stated 2525 and 2511 back in service.

CO. 2 CHIEF MILLER—Miller stated they were busy had 82 calls last month.

<u>CO. 3 CHIEF CALVO</u> – Calvo stated great meeting with the lifeguards and are having a submersion drill with them tomorrow. Met with the presidents of the associations where ideas for signage were discussed for the dune walkways so they can better identify where the lifeguard stands are.

Tutela stated for Calvo to reach out to head of the lifeguard in seaside heights they have a underwater drone they would like to demonstrate.

<u>CO.4 CHIEF GORESH-</u> Goresh thanked the sister fire companies for all their help in the recent weeks. Also stated Roncskevitz has been an asset at the fire scenes.

<u>ISLAND HEIGHTS</u>—Chief McDaniel stated they will be assisting with the fireworks on the river July 4th

SEASIDE HEIGHTS- No representation

FIRE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION- Muttie agreed that Roncskevitz has been a very big asset and the complaints are not coming from District No.1. He stated the fire officer's association had several questions:

- 1. Is Status update on new vehicles that were ordered in February? Convery answered there is no ETA as of yet.
- 2. Has there been further discussion on the bail out system that was requested several months ago? Latshaw stated he needed additional information on how many bail out systems per company were being requested to determine what the cost would be. There is not enough money in the budget this year but will address during the budget to determine where the money is going to come from.
- 3. Met with the vendor re: fire gear. Further discussion tonight on recommendations.
- 4. Requested Gen Tar harnesses and extrication gloves be issued with gear and not come out of tool and equipment line item but out of the general fund.

<u>PARTICIPATION BY THE PUBLIC-</u> Gary Simone Sr. expressed his concerns over the sale of 2500. He stated the light bar is worth what 2500 just sold for and Commissioners are stating there is no money in the budget for other items requested. He asked if any consideration has been placed into the cost of the equipment and has any discussion been placed on assistant chief vehicles.

Convery stated a decision was made many years ago that there will be no assistant chief vehicles and the reason is that as the vehicle ages the costs to maintain the vehicle becomes very costly. Kubiel stated no matter what you sell a vehicle it is irreverent in the budget. There is no general fund within the budget. Each items comes out of a line item.

Robert Alston questioned when money can be transferred into the vehicle maintenance line item and asked what was budgeted. Kubiel stated he believes about \$130,000 and November is when funds can start being transferred.

Bill Roncskevitz- Thanked the fire companies who participated in covering the high school graduations the police department were overwhelmed that the fire department were willing to do that. The fire department was an asset to being there. Working with the district chief and brick that has a rehab unit that is already set up and offering it to Toms River. Currently at no cost but would recommended restocking the items used. It is being handled through the EMS coordinator in Toms River.
