- 1. Place \$82,000 in the 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 budget as reserved capital for future expenditures.
- 2. In 2023 ask the question to buy the vehicles. If they question gets approved, then you purchase the vehicles the following year.
- 3. In 2024- Ocean Beach, 2025 East Dover and 2026 Toms RiverNo.1 and No.2, these station respond together and already have two chiefs responding.

Explanation on how the capital/budget process works. Lengthy discussion followed with concerns on the length of time proposed to purchase the vehicles. The fire officer's association feel assistant chief vehicles are a priority over non-essential vehicles. Tutela stated the commissioners are looking into the best way to fund. Tutela continued to state after listening to all the concerns the fire officers have he is willing to go back to the administrator to see if this can be placed on the ballot for 2022 and purchase in 2023.

Autenrieth recommended placing on the ballot for this year 2020 so the first one can be purchased in 2021.

Motion Autenrieth second Latshaw to place one vehicle on the 2020 ballot for \$55,000 to be purchased in 2021.

WHEREAS, without the appropriations, the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1 will be without funds to pay any and all current bills, as well as future bills that will be incurred during the period of time up until the new election which is scheduled for February 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1 have determined that there exists a need to request these appropriations based upon the facts as set forth above and are satisfied that there is a need for the expenditure to protect and promote the public health, safety, morals and welfare of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1 of Toms River Township as follows:

The total of the appropriations so made shall not exceed 14% of the total of the appropriations made for all purposes in the budget for the preceding fiscal year.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOMS RIVER BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS DISTRICT NO. 1 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF TOMS RIVER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO EMPLOYEES OF THE FIRE DISTRICT TOWARD THEIR EXPENSES AND INCIDENTIALS
