Toms River Fire Training Center Report May 2021

- Outside agencies using the facility in April and May; TRPD K9, NJDFS,
 OC Fire Prevention Assoc., Laurelton VFC, Jackson STA 54, PPBVFC,
 Fire Officer Training, Lakewood FD Engine 3, Ocean Gate VFC, Howell Dist. 1,
 Stafford VFC, Island Heights VFC, and Herbertsville VFC. TR Fire Cos conducted
 live fire and other training and also completed annual mandatory classes and fit
 testing. CPR training is underway for Dist 1 companies which are due this year. We
 currently have 17 more dates scheduled for out of town companies for training
 throughout 2021.
- 2. The regular nighttime FF 1/2 class started Sept 14 with 24 students, 12 TRFD and 12 out of town. There are currently 23 students remaining in the class. All 23 students passed the State Haz Mat Awareness and Operations tests as well as Firefighter Levels 1 and 2. These firefighters are now qualified to operate at fires and other incidents. We have applied for their state certification. EVOC has been completed as has Fire Police Certification and recertification, On Scene Incident Commander, Building Construction, Fire Detection and Suppression Systems, Scene Size up and The Art of Reading Smoke. Fire Officer 1 is ongoing, Fire Instructor 1 is also ongoing. Upcoming classes include, Aerial Apparatus Operator which has been completed, Truck Co Operations now in progress, Air Management, ICS 300, Drill Ground Instructor just completed and Basic Pump School. The 20 courses scheduled are a mix of in person hands on, hybrid and remote learning classes and we have over 200 students enrolled from TR and out of town companies.
- 3. The Academy staff developed interactive online classes to be presented during the period of social distancing. We are offering Fire Officer 2, Building Construction for the Fire Officer and Fire Instructor 2 as fully or partially on line classes. OSIC will no longer be offered as an online class. Also, the Fire Prevention Inspector class is being offered using the Chromebooks the academy purchased last year to save the considerable cost of using printed manuals for the class. Haz Mat Operations refresher course is currently posted for online delivery.
- 4. Several construction and repair projects are or will soon be underway. Roof repairs are awaiting favorable weather. Preventive maintenance and repairs have been completed on the HVAC system, repairs are underway to the standpipe system in the burn building, electrical repairs are underway installing explosion proof fittings in the propane area, LOLL forklift is awaiting repairs. Waste management donated two new burn dumpsters for training and will be presenting a training session on the construction and firefighting issues with LPG powered garbage trucks that serve our communitee. The TRJCCC was instrumental in bringing about this donation. We

expect to have our new (to Us) engine, being donated by the Lakewood FD, at the Academy this week.

5. Manchester is a go for their new combination Fire Dept. They have requested the Academy provide 4 weeks of training including FF/2 and several other classes. All costs will be borne by Manchester. We currently have enough students to conduct a viable FF1/2 day class. We have 4 students from TR and several from out of town. Tuition is \$1,000 per out of town student and the companies involved are aware and agree to the charge. We expect the class to begin on June 28 and conclude on August 13 and we anticipate additional registrations before the start of class.
