The amount to be raised by taxation represents only a portion of the total budget. The remaining revenue comes from District No. 2 for shared costs in operating the Bureau of Fire Prevention, Fire Communication Center and the Fire Training Center; from inspection fees; usage fees; from interest earned on investments; from grants; and from surplus.  <b>YES</b> <input type="radio"/> <b>NO</b> <input type="radio"/>	<b>INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT</b> Approval of this question would authorize Toms River Fire District No. 1 to appropriate \$145,000.00 for the purchase of replacement stationary emergency generators. The generators requiring replacement are over 30 years old and parts availability is scarce making these generators obsolete.  <b>YES</b> <input type="radio"/> <b>NO</b> <input type="radio"/>		<b>INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT</b> Approval of this question would authorize Toms River Fire District No. 1 to appropriate \$100,000.00 for the purchase of replacement vehicles to be used by the Bureau of Fire Prevention. The Board of Fire Commissioners operates the Fire Bureau in conjunction with District No. 2. Toms River Board of Fire Commissioners District No. 2 will reimburse the Toms River Board of Fire Commissioners District No. 1 in the amount of \$36,500.00 for their share of the cost of these vehicles. The Board determines the timing of replacement vehicles utilized by the Bureau based upon the age, mileage and maintenance costs of the vehicles. Upon approval of this question, the Toms River Board of Fire Commissioners will seek the permission to enter into this agreement from the New Jersey Local Finance Board.
