Toms River Fire Training Center Report December 2021

- Outside agencies using the facility in Nov and Dec; Lakewood,
 Lakehurst FC, Jackson Sta 55 (2), Manchester FD, Lanoka harbor, Southard,
 TRPD, NJDFS, Squankum FC, Laurelton CF, Island Heights FC
 Fire companies 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 conducted numerous company drills
 at the Fire Academy including live burns, extrication, propane props and VEIS
 and mayday props. Fit testing has been completed for all Dist 1 companies.
 - 2. The EMT class being hosted by the FA and conducted by RWJBarnabas is continuing with 20 students including 1 from TRFD.

 RWJB has been approved to conduct 3 classes in 2022.
 - 3. Academy classes for the Fall Semester are nearing completion and classes for the winter semester are being planned. In addition to the FF 1/2 class which will finish in late March, we plan to offer a stand alone Firefighter 2 class, ICS 300, and courses required for fire officer qualifications as well as a revised and expanded Truck Company Operations class. The classes are currently being announced on social media outlets. We no longer mail out Fire Academy Schedules. We plan to conduct the FF 2 stand alone class upon the completion of FF 1/2.
 - 4. The propane pump has been reinstalled and is operational. The heating unit in the apparatus bay is down and we are awaiting the arrival of parts.
 - 5. As mentioned above we are planning to present at least 10 classes during the Winter/Spring Semester of 2022. Several of these classes will be those required to advance to the officer ranks. Fire Prevention Inspector is currently underway and Scene Safety Officer has been completed as has the revised extrication class with 25 students.
