**Fire Co#1:**

Kubiell reported he has not received a budget from Fire Co#1. Chief Simone responded that he does not foresee any equipment purchases outside of items that break.

**Fire Co. #2:**

Board reviewed budget requests by Co. #2. Minkler questioned seek cameras, Asst. Chief O'Neill responded these are remainder of cameras requested for this year that were put off until next year.

**Fire Co. #3:**

Board reviewed budget requests by Co. #3. Chief Calvo explained majority of purchases are related to new #2705. Kubiell stated he is working on boat lift rental price which will be added to budget.

**Fire Co. #4:**

Board reviewed budget requests by Co. #4 & Tutela suggested included an additional \$2000 to cover tools needed for new boat.

**District #1:**

Administrator Kubiell informed the Board that although there are no individual budgets for I/T and Radio, we kept the numbers the same with the exception of deleting salaries and benefits for these individuals.

The commissioners reviewed various line items pertaining to the District #1 2023 proposed budget and are satisfied with the overall budget as it stands now.

There being no further business, the workshop ended at 5:20 p.m.
