**COMMUNICATION** - No report

FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU – Minkler stated the advertisement to hire a temporary full time clerical employee has been completed. New Inspector to start on September 26<sup>th</sup> 2022. Tutela stated he conversed with Administrator Kubiel on the two new vehicles that are at Elite for equipment install. Kubiel stated will pick up vehicles without the radio installation because we are waiting on the new radios delivery.

<u>FIRE ACADEMY</u> – Latshaw stated they are working on projects and getting new quotes for the upcoming budget year. Tutela asked Administrator Kubiel to see what the county's cost for paving is. Also asked if Kubiel could contact Public Works to see if they could do the striping.

5. Station 26, 27 and 28 new Knox boxes have been changed over to the new system. It was brought to his attention the possible disconnection issues they are having with the computers may have something to do with their internet. The Bureau informed Chief Cirz of this because the board does not supply their internet service, the company does, and they may have to investigate the issue with their internet provider.
