WHEREAS, District No. 1 desires to award a contract for a lease purchase of radio communications equipment and accessories to Motorola Solutions, Inc. under State Contract #83909 for an amount not exceed \$2,296,754.00 in accordance with the proposal dated August 23, 2023, attached hereto as Schedule A; and

WHEREAS, said award is conditioned upon the approval of the Department of Community Affairs, Local Finance Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by Toms River Township Board of Commissioners, Fire District No. 1, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:
