Kubiel stated you cannot take a line item and drain it to 0. This is not how the budget works. It is placed back in the budget to offset the following year. Tutela stated that we want to see how much is spent this year on percentages to see how much to place in the budget.

Bishop Kenneth Reihl with the Anglican Church of the Americas, offered his services to any member of the fire department. He is currently a Chaplain in Whiting NJ and feels his knowledge and expertise will help firefighters struggling.
